- The community we've worked with is the network of pre-university educational institutions in the county of Iasi.
- FEG worked locally with ISJ, the umbrella-institution for over 400 kindergartens, primary schools and high schools in the county of Iasi. Thus we ensured the access to a large group of teachers, trainers, students, parents and other stakeholders in education, at all levels, from pre-school to post secondary level.
- In the same time, the framework for this partnership gave the possibility to improve also the visibility of other European activities run in the community which at present are left in shadow.
